THE MARS DRINKS COMPOSTING SCHEME

IDEA

FLAVIA have created a recycling scheme which enables new FLAVIA N-viro cups to be collected by Save-a-Cup and turned into compost for use in farming and horticulture!

This is the first collection scheme in the UK to enable workplaces to send their compostable cups to industrial composting facilities. This scheme has the potential to divert thousands of cups away from landfill and can help you to reduce waste in your workplace. *

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Used FLAVIA N-viro cups are collected by Save-a-Cup and sent to a range of industrial composting facilities across the UK. At the composting sites, the FLAVIA N-viro cups are mixed with food and green waste to speed up the process. After approximately 2-3 months the end result is quality compost which will be used in farming and horticulture to put nutrients back into the soil.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

1. Contact Save-a-Cup once you have received your first delivery of compostable cups and fill in a simple registration form quoting the reference number on your cases.
2. Collect your used FLAVIA cups in the special cup collection bins and biodegradable bin bags provided by Save-a-Cup.

3. Save-a-Cup will then collect the FLAVIA cups from your site on a fortnightly basis to be composted in industrial composting facilities.
4. We recommend you arrange employee training to educate your workforce on correct recycling procedures. Promotional material is available from Mars Drinks.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

- £50 annual administration fee.
- £20 per fortnightly site collection (Includes collection of FLAVIA N-viro cups, plastic cups and filter packs as well as KLIX plastic cups waste).
- £135 plus delivery per N-viro cup bin.
- Save-a-Cup compostable bin sacks are available in packs of 100 at £40.00 per pack. (40p per unit)

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

By joining the scheme you can:

- Contribute to meeting your environmental targets and help satisfy corporate recycling policies.
- Reduce the waste your workplace sends to landfill which may help to reduce the amount of landfill tax your business has to pay.
- Show your employees that their voice is heard.
- Advertise your green credentials by using the Save-a-Cup logo and being part of a scheme that turns N-viro cups into compost.

DID YOU KNOW?

Save-a-Cup can collect your used FLAVIA filterpacks at the same time as they collect your FLAVIA N-viro cups for no extra annual charge or site collection fee! FLAVIA's Waste2Energy scheme means used filterpacks from your workplace can be used to generate electricity.

KLIX and FLAVIA plastic cups can also be collected, these are then recycled into useful objects such as pens or even cup holders.
